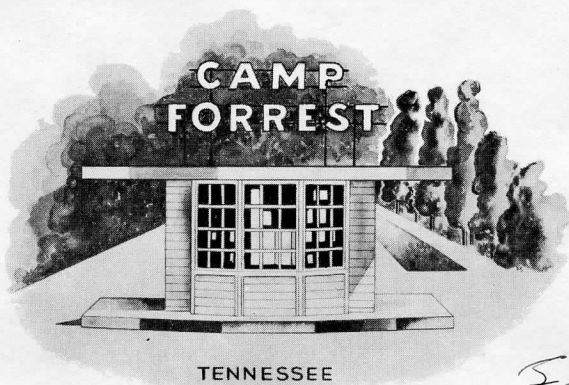




Sept 17, 1942
